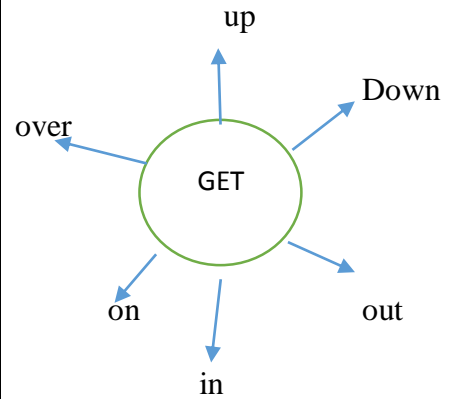
Page 1- Subject, Topic and the name Multiple Assessment 1
