Now that we are in the lockdown mode for 21 days, as announced by the Prime Minister, we have planned a weekly **Fun Work** for the kids. Hope that they will enjoy doing these activities under your guidance. Let's together help our students to use their time productively and engage in some creative learning.

**(18<sup>th</sup> April - 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2020)**

Given below are a list of activities which the students are supposed to take up during the given week.

**Activity 1**- Creative writing:

a) Compose a short poem on your own using homophones on any topic of your choice. Highlight the homophones in your poem using crayons or colour pencils on an A4 size sheet and decorate the borders.

Note: Homophones are words that sound alike but they have different meanings and spellings. Ex: We went to the seashore to see/sea a blue/blew whale. We played under the hot sun/son and had a lot of fun their/there.

b) We know that Doraemon uses different gadgets to help and improve Nobita's life. Think and write - If you could invent any new tool that would improve your life in some way, what would you create? How would it work? What would it do for you or when would you use it? Write on an A4 size paper. You can draw your gadget too.

**Activity- 2:** Do the given work on an A4 size sheet, decorate the borders with crayons or colour pencils.

**Telugu:** Explain dwitva, samyukta, samsleshakra padaalu. Write five examples for each kind of padaalu.

### Activity 3- Think Smart

a) Do the given Math activity neatly on an A4 size sheet.

Solve the following fraction word problems.

1) Last night there was a pizza party at home. 16 pizza pieces were left. I ate  $\frac{4}{16}$  and tom ate  $\frac{5}{16}$  slices. What fraction of slices we ate all together?

2) I have 20 books. Some are English and some are French. If 15 books are French, what fraction of books are English?

3) There are 35 students in my class. 15 are girls and 20 are boys. What fraction of students are girls?

4) John has homework to do in 3 days. He completed  $\frac{4}{15}$  yesterday and did  $\frac{7}{15}$  of the work today. How much work he has completed?

5) There are 42 children in a village.  $\frac{13}{42}$  children have fever and  $\frac{21}{42}$  children have bad throat. What fraction of children are ill all together?

6) 20 children are standing outside a room.  $\frac{17}{20}$  children entered the room. Now  $\frac{5}{20}$  children who entered earlier, went outside. What fraction is still inside?

b) Complete the following multiplication grid. Write the given numbers with black pen and for the others use different colors. Use the numbers given vertically to multiply with those given horizontally. For eg.  $12 \times 2 = 24$ ,  $12 \times 5 = 60$  and so on.

**Activity 4- Let's create a newspaper.** Follow the instructions given below-

- How to make it: A lot is happening around the world. Nature is healing, Pollution is less, Young scientists working on vaccine invention.
- You can start by dividing your paper into various sections such as National News, Local News, Weather, Precautions, Advertisements or even quizzes.
- Next, collect the articles or pictures that you would want to put in your paper.
- Once you have collected all the news you want to report, it's time to put it together.
- Keep the size in mind. (An A4 sheet)
- Take pictures of the news from internet and stick it on your paper.
- You can then write a small report about the news item that you have reported. Don't forget to give a name to your newspaper and to write your name on top of the report. After all you are the reporter!

**Activity 5- Art and craft:** Let's make a bird house. Collect the material required and follow the instructions given below.

1. Shoe box
2. Wrapping paper
3. Scissors
4. Scotch tape

**Method:**

1. Dust and clean out your shoe box. Use long, rectangular kind rather than the square kind.
2. Draw a circle on the top flap.
3. Cut the circle out.
4. Tape the top and the bottom part of your shoe box.
5. Begin to wrap your shoe box with your choice of wrapping paper.  
(If you're not having wrapping paper you can use paints)
6. Make sure you don't forget your circle, it's the only way the birds can enter.
7. You can wrap your two cardboard rectangles in wrapping paper too. Place your rectangles in a triangle shape and tape them at the top.

Note: you can cut rectangles out from another shoe box, cereal box or other cardboard boxes.



8. Put your rectangles on the top of the shoe box and tape it at the sides. Now add some bird seeds and wait for birds to come and visit.
